

Tewksbury Business Association Members Children Scholarship

1. Two scholarships at 500.00 each shall be awarded annually by the Tewksbury Business Association. One Male and One female shall be awarded these scholarships
2. All applicants must be pursuing a degree in business.
3. No applicant shall be discriminated against because of race, sex, creed or national origin.
4. No award shall be made if in the judgment of the scholarship committee, the applicant is not properly qualified.
5. Scholarship awards shall be made payable by check to the student.
6. Scholarship awards shall be granted to properly qualified students whose parents are currently members in good standing of the Tewksbury Business Association Scholarship awards are limited to members of the senior class of any secondary, public, private or parochial school regardless of locale, provided the applicant resides in the state of Massachusetts and shall be awarded on the following bases a) academic qualifications b) Essay c)interview by scholarship committee d)current years transcript.

Applications must be received no later than April 17, 2010

No party may be eligible for consideration that is not child of a member of the Tewksbury Business Association. Tewksbury Business Association member's children are only eligible for the member's scholarship award.

All applications become the property of the Tewksbury Business Association and cannot be returned.

A complete application must contain the following (4) parts:

The applications must be filled out completely and signed by the applicant and his/her parent(s) or guardian(s);

An 800 word essay listing particular interests and activities, this letter must also include a description of the profession or career that you intend to prepare for in a college or university setting, as well as your future aspirations.

An official transcript of grades received during the four years of high school or three years of high school and all grades received through March of the applicant's senior year.

If chosen as a finalist a personal interview with the scholarship committee will be scheduled.

Your application will be automatically disqualified if all three parts listed above are not received in one envelope postmarked no later than **April 17, 2010 NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**

Recipients will be initially notified by telephone and subsequently by mail of their selection for the final interview no later than April 30, 2010.

Having submitted an application or being selected for a final interview does not guarantee receipt of
